Dr. Michael Krone**

When Dr. Michael Krone moved to Richmond from Louisiana in 1995, he knew he wanted to give back to his new community.

**Virginia State Employee Giving Opportunity**

**Attention All State of Virginia Employees!!!**

**October 5<sup>th</sup> is the Official Kickoff for the Commonwealth of Virginia's Charity Giving Campaign.**



On that day, the state's E-Direct Online Giving website opens. The Commonwealth of Virginia Campaign gives each of its employees an opportunity the chance to create a positive change in our community by supporting the charity of your choice by making a donation.

Agencies supported by the campaign are making a difference in many lives in our community. This year the focus is on making it possible for every employee to give. The "Virginia is for Givers" campaign slogan reflects the years of generous donations to CVC charities by state employees.

If you are an employee of the State of Virginia, you have the choice to select from more than 1,000 charities from which to designate your gifts. **CrossOver has been selected as one of the many charities you may contribute to through this campaign.**

If you donate directly to a charity that is enrolled in CVC, your donation can still count towards the charity's CVC total! This also includes registration fee for 5k's, and other charity events that have a registration fee. If the charity is enrolled in CVC, you can count your registration fee as a Direct Give for CVC!

**Important dates to remember:**

- Official campaign kickoff day - Wednesday, October 5, 2016 – Donations are accepted year round.
- Last date to pledge online through E-Direct for payroll deductions – Thursday, December 15, 2016
- Last date to donate using a paper pledge card for payroll deduction gifts – Thursday, December, 15, 2016
- Last date to donate via cash, credit card, or check to count for your current year taxes – Friday, December 30, 2016
- Last date to pledge online for credit card gifts - January 31, 2017
- Last date to donate via paper pledge card to count towards current campaign – January 31, 2017
