### Henrico Clinic

This year, we built out a brand new HIV clinic at our Henrico Clinic location and moved our HIV program out of the Richmond Clinic and into this new space.

Our clients tell us they appreciate the spacious exam rooms, natural light, and ample parking, all of which lend a sense of comfort and ease to their appointments.

### **Richmond Clinic**

We continue to make improvements to our Richmond Clinic, including painting our exam rooms and repurposing the space vacated by our HIV program. As a result, we now have a new patient intake area that is comfortable, private, and respectful of patient confidentiality.

At both clinics, we continue to work toward our goal of having spaces that reflect the dignity of our patients and the excellence of the care they receive here.













### WELCOMING OUR NEIGHBORS

### Our newest neighbors

This year brought a new partnership with the Virginia Department of Health to provide new refugee health screenings at CrossOver. Appointments are for the entire family, and they include communicable disease screening, vaccination, and establishing patients with CrossOver as their health home. Working with local resettlement agencies, CrossOver is able to help address the unique needs facing these new arrivals in a compassionate and culturally sensitive way.

## Pregnant patients and our youngest neighbors

This year saw a 37% increase in our number of OB patient visits and a 29% increase in our number of pediatrics patient visits compared to FY22. At CrossOver, our pediatric and OB clients have access to dental care, vaccinations, eye care, and our full range of services important for healthy pregnancies and childhoods.
